STUDENT CONNECT CODE

How do I use the Connect Code?

Your AUSD Google ID is your Connect Code.

To check out library materials, provide your Google ID or your name and date of birth to a staff member at the service desk.

If you need a password or PIN to access a library resource, enter your birth month and day (MMDD.)



**WiFi Hotspots and items in the Library of Things cannot be borrowed*

What can I check out from the library?

- You may borrow up to 5 physical items from the library*
- You can use the computers at the library
- You can access the library’s digital resources, such as e-books, e-audiobooks, and streaming content

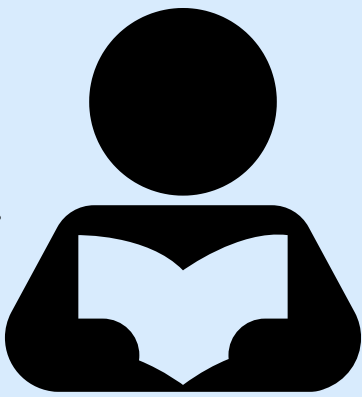
Where can I use my Connect Code?
